- Can be fabricated with patterned glass for increased aesthetics; coated, tinted, or low-E glass for thermal control.

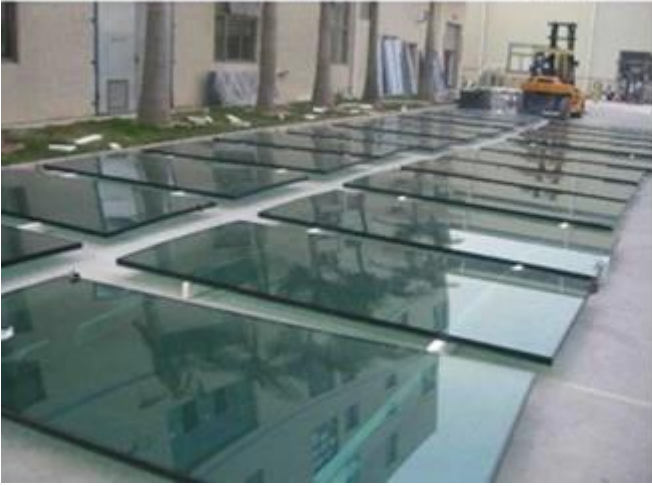
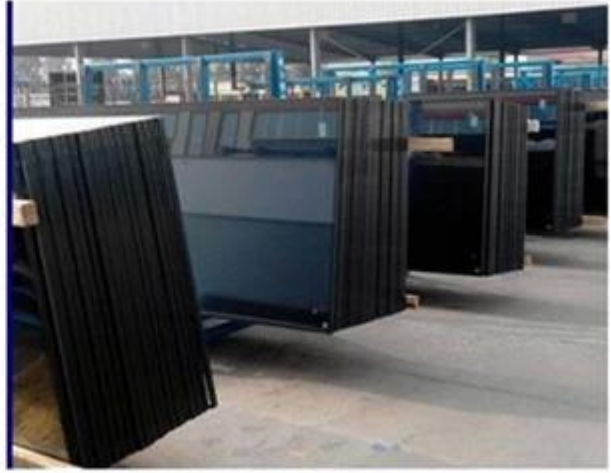
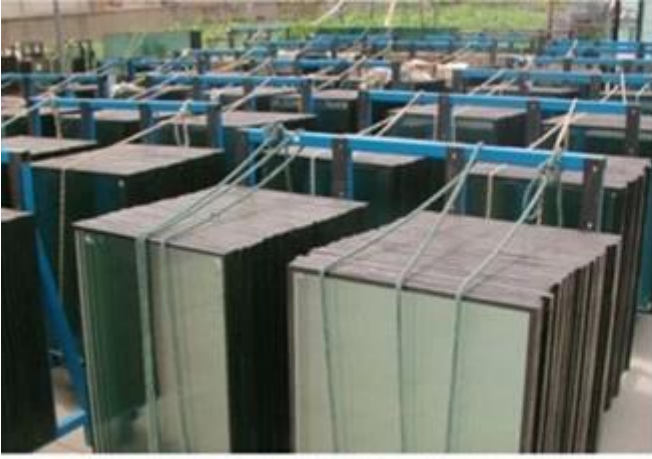
